And EVERYBODY looked around for SOMEBODY to blame.

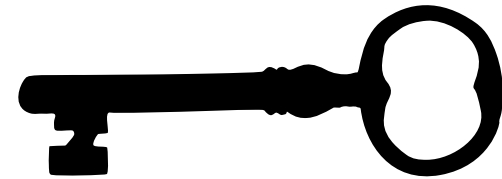
SOMEBODY should have done the job and EVERYBODY would have,
