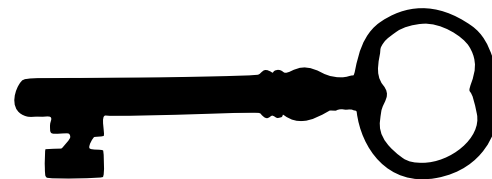
Church Needs
